

BIOGRAPHIES

MONIKA BROWNE-ECKER* (Production Manager) has been a member of the Theatre B ensemble since 2018. She has previously performed with the company in Hamlet, Marjorie Prime, The Art of Bad Men, and Re-Entry. Monika directed the Meditation Retreat at the Plains Art Museum, assistant directed The Santaland Diaries and has worked on design for multiple Theatre B productions, including The Roommate, The Last Schwartz, Blackbird, Church & State, A Beautiful Hell, I Will Not Go Gently, 1984, and Straight White Men.

JACOB HARTJE* (Assistant Director, Camera Operator, Understudy) is an active member of the theatre community and an ensemble member of Theatre B. He has appeared in *The Last Schwartz, Hamlet, Church & State, 1984*, and *Equivocation*.

DAVID "HUBIE" HUEBNER* (Live Stream Director, Voting App Design) specializes in technical theatre ranging from lighting design, to shoving boxes into a truck, to serving as the venue representative for a number of national tours at venues around town including The Fargo Theatre. He has a particular knack for inventing low budget solutions to high concept designs. Many of these solutions appeared at Trollwood from 2008-2017 and also in Moorhead High School's productions of *Tommy* and *Peter Pan*. His work with Theatre B began in 2015 and includes lighting design for *Blackbird, Hamlet,* and *The Sweet New.* Hubie is a software developer at Bushel where he is passionate about storing data in RFC-3339 and e.164 formats, as well as finding problems before you do.

HARDY KOENIG (Dialect Coach) has an MFA in acting from The University of North Carolina at Greensboro. He retired last year from the theatre department at NDSU. Hardy's last production at Theatre B was as Ray in *Blackbird*.

TUCKER LUCAS* (Director, Sound Design, Video Production) is a director, podcaster, and performer who has worked in many capacities at Theatre B since joining the ensemble in 2007. He has performed in *Rabbit Hole, The Pillowman, The 39 Steps, God of Carnage* and most recently in the title role of *Hamlet*. Previous directing credits include *The Santaland Diaries* and *The Underpants*. He currently produces the weekly podcast JJ Meets World and works as the Video Producer at H2M in Fargo.

BRIAN LYNCH (Scenic and Lighting Design) holds a BFA from NDSU in Theatre Arts. Brian often collaborates with Theatre B, with design work including *Cry it Out, Blackbird, Church and State, I Will Not Go Gently, Marjorie Prime,* and *Hand to God.* You may have also seen Brian's work in productions at the FM Ballet or the Fargo Moorhead Community Theatre. He currently works for Fargo Public Schools.

BIOGRAPHIES

CLARE LYNCH* (Robbie) joined the ensemble in 2019, having previously performed on the Theatre B stage in *Church & State, The Moors, Equivocation,* and *The Art of Bad Men.* She graduated from NDSU in 2015 with a BFA in Theatre Arts, where she also served as the chair of Newfangled Theatre Company and as a student assistant in the costume shop. Clare currently works at Super Studio in downtown Fargo and teaches dance fitness classes at NDSU and the YMCA.

LEAH VOGEL (Production and Live-Stream Stage Manager) is proud to be a part of this unique production. She has worked with Theatre B the last 2 years in the "holiday" slot, as Stage Manager for *The Santaland Diaries* and *The Last Schwartz*. After graduating from NDSU, Leah interned in Stage Management at The Juilliard School and then spent 7 years in NYC working in Stage and Production Management. Locally, Leah has stage managed nine productions with FM Opera, two NDSU Opera Theatre productions, and took on Theatre NDSU's *Into the Woods* last winter. She also recently made the trek to Duluth, MN to stage manage for Lyric Opera of the North's production of *Elixir of Love*. She continues to "daylight" as a substitute teacher at her alma mater, Oak Grove Lutheran School.
